ACCOMMODATION & LIVING COST

Dormitory	<p>*100% of international students are required to live on campus. (International House) *International House, Usually in a room 2 Koreans and 2 International students will live together. *International students may choose to live in regular dormitory where the main language spoken is Korean and all the staff members speak Korean. *Dormitory Fee= 684,000KRW / Semester (about \$560, 560EUR)</p>
Living Conditions	<p>*3-4 students share a room *Furniture include beds, desks, bookshelves, closets in each room *Facilities: shower stalls, latrines, laundry room, lounge *Only International dorm has a kitchen where students can cook meals.</p>
